### Chapter 5 Admission to the Programme

#### Art 5.2. Admission to the programme

##### 5.2.2.a. Hardship clause applicable to students and bridging programme students due to COVID-19 measures

1. As a special measure arising from the COVID-19 pandemic, at the student's request, the Board of Admissions can decide to admit a student who is preparing for the final exam of the bachelor's programme/bridging programme for one year, provided the student only needs to pass components with a joint study load of at most 15 credits (EC). In the case of a bridging programme, these credits do not include the Bachelor's thesis; the thesis must be completed by 30 September 2021 at the latest.
2. Once the student has passed the final exam of the bachelor's programme/bridging programme, admission for the remaining months will be converted to a definite admission.
3. If the student, who has started as of 1 September 2021, has not passed the final exam of the bachelor's programme/bridging programme by 31 August 2022 at the latest, he/she will be excluded from further participation in the master's programme until the bachelor's exam/bridging programme exam has been passed.
4. Article 5.2.2.a. becomes effective once emergency legislation relating to study delays resulting from COVID-19 (Wijziging van de Wet op het hoger onderwijs en wetenschappelijk onderzoek en de Wet studiefinanciering 2000 betreffende tijdelijke voorzieningen voor het studiejaar 2021-2022 in verband met COVID-19) enters into force.
