Bestuurlijke reactie BA Koreastudies

The programme appreciates all recommendations, advice and suggestions of the assessment panel. Based on the assessment report, the programme has drawn up a Plan of Action and is already implementing it to improve the quality of education.

Program size:

- Number of incoming students is now at a level that current staff numbers have been insufficient for some years. The program goal is consolidation of student numbers, not growth.
- The expectations of a part of the students (language acquisition, superficial interest in K- culture) do not match with the setup of the program. Without a binding student selection system in order, there is relatively little that the program can do to manage incoming students.

Study abroad / shadow program:

The current 6-month study abroad is untenable with rising student numbers.
Installing a shadow program for students who do not go abroad is necessary, but requires investments from staff that have not been possible up to now.
