The assessment committee concluded that the programme met the four assessment standards of the accreditation framework and reached a positive general final assessment. Below are some recommendations of the committee and the responses of the study programme to them:

More attention to methodology in the curriculum/theses

As of 2022-2023, methodology has been made more explicit in the intended learning outcomes and will be given more attention in both taught courses and the theses.

Fill vacancies with staff to enhance team diversity and strengthen multi-, inter- and transdisciplinary dimensions of the programme

LUCAS has, within the given possibilities, taken this recommendation into account in recent appointments.

Invite alumni and/as guest lecturers to share their hands-on experience

The programme is working on its relationship with alumni and on inviting them to share their professional experiences with the students.

Broaden the range of innovative assessment methods

The programme has introduced a more diverse package of test formats: e.g. writing of papers and presentations during lectures, a conference day, vlogs, positioning papers, grant applications for conferences or journals, and peer reviews.
