The assessment committee concluded that the programme met the four assessment standards of the accreditation framework and reached a positive general final assessment. Below are some recommendations of the committee and the responses of the study programme to them:

Ensure that the extra requirement in MA courses is assessed in a fitting way

In order to ensure that the extra requirement for ResMA students in MA level courses always matches the desired ResMA level, the programme has improved the information in the prospectus: courses that qualify for the extra requirement have clearly spelled out their requirements for ResMA students. In addition, the programme has taken steps to periodically remind staff about the extra requirement and accompanying assessment rubric. The Board of Examiners will pay attention to this topic in their periodical quality checks.

Raise awareness of (holistic) assessment practices

In the absence of rubrics in thesis assessment, the Board of Examiners will include the programme's deliberate holistic assessment practice in the meetings they periodically organise for staff, to discuss calibration of grades.

Strengthen the alumni policy

The programme will explore ways in which it can have a GDPR-proof system of being in touch with its alumni, in order to be able to keep track of their careers.
