

## **Bestuurlijke reactie Bachelor en master Culturele Antropologie en Ontwikkelingssociologie**

The Institute will strengthen the profile in terms of audiovisual forms of knowledge production and distribution as well as its signature methodology (in both Bachelor and Master).

The institute will make steps forward to prepare students better for the professional field, by emphasizing and teaching the relevance of anthropological knowledge and skills for addressing societal problems (also in both Bachelor and Master).

The institute will achieve a new set-up for the Bachelor thesis which 1) links the thesis more explicitly to the teaching-learning trajectory that the panel defined as “skills and attitude” (“leerlijn 4” in the Self Evaluation), 2) strengthens the intended analysis of the theoretical foundation of case studies, and 3) redefines the intended learning outcome with regard to career perspectives.

The institute will intensify the programme’s guidance system (“tutoraat”) as integrated part of the International Bachelor programme and articulate this to its efforts to communicate more explicitly about its impressive resources and potential.

Procedures for thesis assessment will be harmonized within the new procedures for the Faculty of Social and Behavioural Sciences.
